Become SKPA Accredited —teach clinics in your area

Many photographers are interested in receiving SKPA training in their part of the country. However, it is too costly for a Western-based SKPA trainer to travel long distances unless the class is large enough to support the expense.

SKPA now has an extensive (but easy to follow) two-part training manual prepared for those who want to hold SKPA classes in their own studio! The manual and Power-Point CD with 500+ slides is available for \$399 (pending SKPA board approval).
